SCHOOL SORES/IMPETIGO

'School Sores' (Impetigo) is a highly contagious skin infection and confirmed cases have occurred at school.

Tonight please check your child's skin for any unusual irritations. Usually the sores are on the face, hands or scalp.

The infection starts as small red spots that change into blisters that fill with pus. These blisters pop, weep then form crusts. It spreads through skin to skin contact.

Children need to stay at home until doctor prescribed antibiotics have been administered for at least 24 hours.

Weeping or crusted sores on exposed areas should be covered with a water tight dressing until at least 24 hours after antibiotics have been started and until sores have healed.


