

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Dear Parents,

This letter is to inform you of an increase in the 2022 student book pack levy.

At this term's P&C meeting, a motion was passed to raise the student textbook levy to \$45.00 per child in 2022. The School Voluntary contribution will remain the same.

The book pack levy covers the cost of workbooks, textbooks, stationery, e.g. pencils, glue, art & craft supplies, and online learning program subscriptions such as Mathletics, Inquisitive, Top Ten Maths and Reading Eggs.

The general school contribution helps our school fund the cost of our excellent classroom resources, classroom readers, library books, and technology resources, such as laptops and iPads. This general contribution levy is \$30 for one child, and for those families with two or more children at school, the levy is \$50 per family.

We're very fortunate to have fantastic resources at our school, and the money we receive through this contribution helps to maintain our resources at this high standard.

Payments can be made through the Parents Online Payment system (via the school website 'Make a Payment' tab), cash or cheque at the office at any time. (*Please make cheques payable to Dunoon Public School*)
