5/6 News

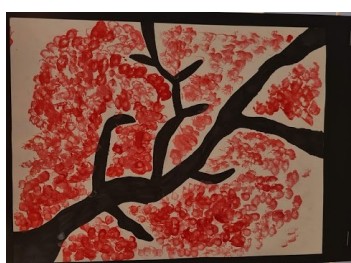
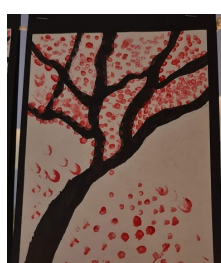
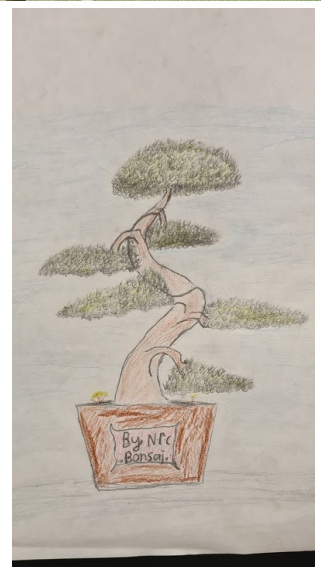
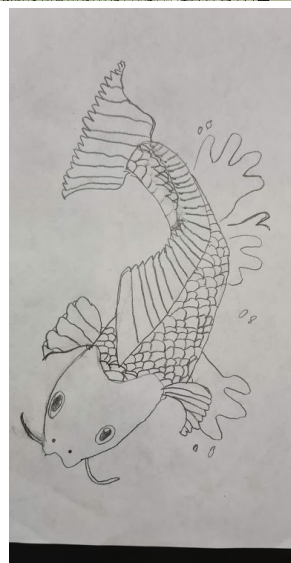
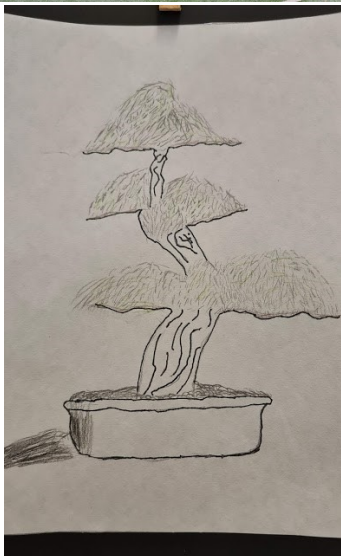
Our 5/6 class is motoring along in their final year or two of primary school. Students are working well on their Asian country study project and we are finding out lots of interesting information about the continent.
