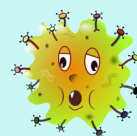


COVID 19

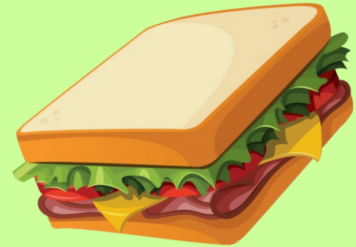
