







K-2 Reading Support.

In line with the new English Curriculum, we have purchased an online Reading package to support students with reading at home and within the classroom. Students will have access to decodable reading texts that are specifically levelled and targeted for each individual student. Below are some tips for helping your child when reading at home.



Our new online program will be accessed by students online and is similar to reading eggs with each student having their own username and password. Decodable Readers Australia have designed the program to be engaging without the 'games based' approach that Reading Eggs takes. We encourage parents to have their children read aloud at least 3 nights a week.



Student log in details will be sent home this week.

Decodable Readers Australia offers a number of online supports for parents and provides a clear structure to the reading learning process.

You may wish to log in and check out some of this information for yourselves.




